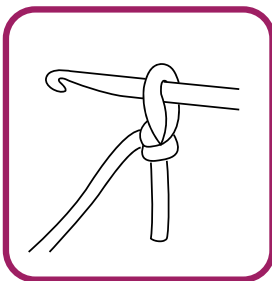
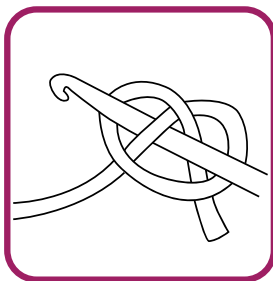

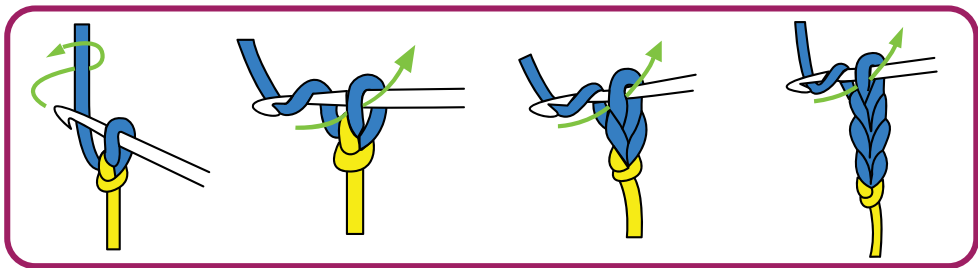

A stitch marker is a small tool that marks a specific stitch or the start/end of a round. It helps you keep track of your place, count stitches accurately, and catch mistakes before you go too far.

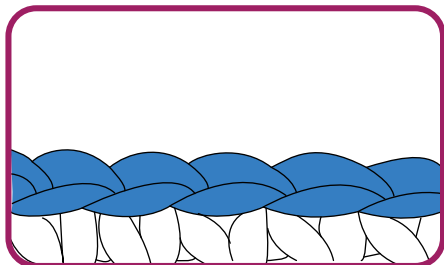

The MAKING



1. Ice Cream Head (Yarn used: Pink)

R1: Magic ring, 3 sc [3 sts]

R2: inc, 1 sc [4 sts]

R3: FLO, 2 sc, 2 hdc-inc [6 sts]

R4: 2 sc-inc, 4 $\times$ (2dc-inc) [12 sts]

R5: FLO, 2dc-inc, 10 sc [14 sts]

R6: 2 sc, 10hdc-inc [24 sts]

R7: FLO, (3 hdc, hdc-inc) $\times$ 3 times, (3 sc, sc-inc) $\times$ 3 times [30 sts]

R8: (2 sc, inc, 2 sc) $\times$ 6 times [36 sts]

R9: (5 sc, inc) $\times$ 6 times [42 sts]

R10 – 11: 42 sc [42 sts]

R12: FLO, (3 sc, inc, 3 sc) $\times$ 6 times [48 sts]

R13: (7 sc, inc) $\times$ 6 times [54 sts]

R14: (4 sc, inc, 4 sc) $\times$ 6 times [60 sts]

R15: 60 sc [60 sts]

R16: (4 sc, dec, 4 sc) $\times$ 6 times [54 sts]

R17: (7sc, dec) $\times$ 6 (48)

F/O – Leaving a long tail.



2. Body (Yarn used: Yellow, Light Yellow)

R1: Magic ring, 6 sc [6 sts]
R2: 6 inc [12 sts]
R3: (sc, inc) $\times$ 6 times [18 sts]
R4: (sc, inc, sc) $\times$ 6 times [24 sts]
R5: 24 sc [24 sts]
R6: 2 sc, inc, (5 sc, inc) $\times$ 3 times, 3 sc [28 sts]
R7: 28 sc [28 sts]
R8: 3 sc, inc, (6 sc, inc) $\times$ 3 times, 3 sc [32 sts]
R9: 32 sc [32 sts]
R10: 4 sc, inc, (7 sc, inc) $\times$ 3 times, 3 sc [36 sts]
R11 – 12: 36 sc [36 sts]
R13: 5 sc, inc, (8 sc, inc) $\times$ 3 times, 3 sc [40 sts]
R14: 40 sc [40 sts]
R15: 6 sc, inc, (9 sc, inc) $\times$ 3 times, 3 sc [44 sts]
R16: 7 sc, inc, (10 sc, inc) $\times$ 3 times, 3 sc [48 sts]
R17: Change to light yellow yarn. FLO, 48 sc [48 sts]
R18 – 19: 48 dc [48 sts]



Fold the light yellow section downward.

Lightly shape the cone opening.
Using stitch markers, evenly align the cone to the ice cream body before sewing.



Insert the safety eyes now before attaching the body to the cone.

Place the eyes between R14–15, approximately 1.25 inches (3 cm) apart. Stuff lightly with fiberfill. Continue to assembly.



Align and sew the ice cream body to the cone. When 2/3 sewn, continue stuffing firmly with fiberfill. Finish sewing closed.

3. Arms x 2 (Yarn used: Yellow)

R1: Yellow yarn,
3sc in magic ring [3 sts]
R2-8: 3sc [3 sts]
F/O, leaving a long tail.



4. Hands x 2 (Yarn used: Yellow)

R1: Yellow yarn, 3sc in magic
ring [6 sts]
R2: 6inc [12 sts]
R3: 6dec [6 sts]
F/O, leaving a long tail.
Stuff the hand with fiberfill
and insert a 12cm wire.
Thread the wire into the arm,
then sew the hand to the arm.



5. Glasses (Yarn used: Blue)

R1: With blue yarn and wire, shape the wire into a loop and crochet around the wire:
18 sc, 2 hdc, 2 dc, 2 hdc, 11 sc.
For the bridge: Ch 3.

Without fastening off, shape the second wire loop and crochet around the wire:
18 sc, 2 hdc, 2 dc, 2 hdc, 11 sc. Sl st to the base of the bridge to secure.
F/O, leaving a long tail for sewing.



The ASSEMBLY



REMINDER



Reminder to place
your stitch heart!

Your **Stitch Heart** is extra special before you close your creation, hold it tight, make a wish, or send it some good energy. Then place it inside the stuffing to make your character truly one-of-a-kind!

1. Embroider the Face

1. With white yarn, embroider the eye whites onto the ice cream head. Attach safety eyes between the embroidered eye whites.
2. With black yarn, embroider the smiling mouth.
3. With white yarn, embroider the small teeth below the mouth.



2. Sew on the Eyeglasses

1. Position the completed blue eyeglasses over the embroidered eyes on the ice cream head.
2. Sew securely around the edges of the glasses using blue yarn.
3. Pull snug, fasten off, and weave in the ends.



3. Add Decorative Patterns

1. Using chain stitch with yellow yarn, create decorative patterns of suitable length.
2. Sew the patterns onto the cup body.
3. Repeat to complete all decorative details.



4. Sew on the Arms

1. Position the finished arm-hand assemblies on each side of the ice cream body.
2. Thread a needle with yellow yarn (matching the body).
3. Sew securely around the base of each arm to attach firmly to the body.
4. Pull snug, fasten off, and weave in the ends.
